The books contain no duplications from previous volumes except changes of data supplied by member. Included are name, birth, marriage, and death dates when known. Wives are cross-indexed with maiden names. Each book is 8 1/2 x 11" and soft cover. Photocopies of individual charts are available from OCGS for \$.25 per page plus first-class postage. When requesting copies, include name(s) of interest with volume and page number.
