Rochester, MI September 3, 2007 --The Rochester Junior Woman’s Club is preparing for its 9th Annual Lobster Boil on Saturday, September 29, 2007. You plan the party and the RJWC will cook the lobsters. It’s a great way to entertain friends and family or enjoy a quiet dinner for two. You choose the pick-up time and they will cook them, wrap them, and have them hot and ready for you at the OPC drive-thru site. You don’t even have to get out of your car! The lobsters will stay HOT for up to 2 hours in the wrappers.

The whole New England lobsters will be flown in fresh early that morning. Each lobster will be between 1 and 1 ¼ pounds each. The RJWC will be cooking the lobsters on-site at the Older Persons’ Commission located at 650 Letica Drive in Rochester. Orders will be taken through September 19th for live or cooked lobsters. If you prefer to order your lobsters live, please bring a container to transport them home. The lobsters are \$16 each. Buy bakers dozen and get the 13th one free.

Proceeds from this years’ Lobster Boil will benefit the OPC, Meals on Wheels, South Oakland Shelter, Rochester Hills Museum at Van Hoosen Farm and Meadow Brook Hall Garden Club and other local charities.
