Article II: Dues

Membership shall be forfeited and a written notice sent to the Recording Secretary that the member is not in good standing if dues are not received by June 30th. Members whose dues are not paid by June 30th must reapply in writing for membership in the club within seven (7) days, or forfeit their membership.

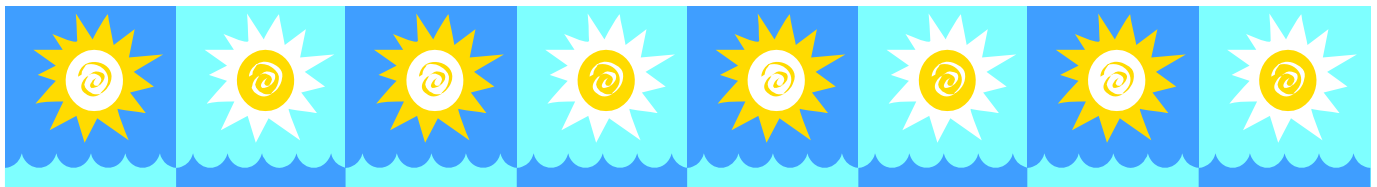
