The following 3 motions were made at the September 15, 2011 general membership meeting:



- **Toni Wiley made a motion to accept the budget as proposed. Lauren Sitko seconded. The motion was voted on and passed.**
- **Two By Law changes were proposed and motions made as follows**
- **Section 4. In order to be eligible for an Executive Board Position the candidate must be an Active Member for 2 full years having joined by the November General Meeting and either served as Chair / Co-Chair of a department or Chair/ Co-Chair of a major fundraiser. Lynn Oates made a motion to accept. Nancy Kamman seconded. The motion was voted on and passed.**
- **Section 5. If there is no eligible candidate/nominee for the office of President-Elect the following will occur: A small group of Past Presidents will fill in until a candidate is available. As set forth in Article III , Section 10 of the By- Laws: All vacancies occurring among elected officers shall be filled for the remainder of their term by appointment by the Club President, subject to the vote of the General Membership. New Members would fall under the Chair/Co-Chair of the New Member Department until the office of President- Elect is filled. If during the club year the President-Elect office remains vacant, the Past- Presidents would fill in for the President position on a rotating basis. Linda Dill made a motion to accept. Lynn Oates seconded. The motion was voted on and passed.**

Inspired by the true story of the Laundry Project, this play tells the story of the women of Lockerbie and their determination to convert an act of hate into an act of love, as they wash the clothes of the dead and return them to the victims' families. Bureaucracy tries to stand in their way. The tragedy is seen through the eyes of one American family and the residents of the little town whose lives were changed forever.
